Library Services

Library Hours



The Library is opened 58 hours a week and the Testing Center is opened 47 hours each week.

The Library is a popular gathering place for students looking for quiet study carrels, working and researching using the computers, collaborating on their group projects, or taking a 15 minutes respite between classes. The annual gate count for the Library is more than 350,000 or about 2,000 per day.

Library Computers, Printers, Instruction and Testing Facilities



The open computer lab provides over:

- 70 computers
- 30 laptops
- 3 black and white and 2 color printers
- 2 photocopiers

Two library instruction rooms and the Testing Center provide more than:

- 50 computers
- 20 laptops
- 42 Testing computers

Journal Article Databases

	EBSCO's <i>Business Source Premier</i>, <i>Academic Search Premier</i>, and <i>Computer Source</i> provide access to scholarly peer-reviewed journals, trade magazines, industry reports, company profiles and news. These three databases are heavily used by our BLT faculty and students. Usage for <i>Business Source Premier</i> in 2014 was over 8,500 sessions, an increase of 37% from 2013; more than 7,000 articles were downloaded or 40% increase from the previous year.
	<i>ScienceDirect</i> provides full-text access to almost 120 highly ranked academic journals in. This is also a highly popular database with faculty and students.
	<i>ProQuest Honolulu Newspaper</i> provides local and national business news.
	<i>Statista</i> contains current statistical information, reports, and forecasts from government and industry sources.

Book and Electronic Book Collections

	<i>Hawai'i Voyager</i> provides student and faculty access to the book collections across all the University of Hawai'i libraries. Kapi'olani Community College Library maintains over 4,000 print titles in the BLT subject areas.
	<i>Ebrary's Business & Economics</i> collection holds more than 15,700 books while the <i>Computers & IT</i> collection has almost 3,000 titles. Other related collections in <i>Ebrary</i> include Psychology and Social Sciences.
	EBSCO <i>eBook Collection</i> has a smaller set of Business, Economics, Computer Science, and Law ebooks.
