Aloha kakou! Hope the semester is treating you well!

Acceptance letters are being sent to Spring 2017 new students. This is an automatically generated email from Starfish, sent by the system (see attached). We also have a slightly new process below so that we can generate different interventions based on whether students immediately express interest in attending, by completing the Intent to Enroll Form, or if they don't respond.

1. Student Receives Acceptance Letter
2. Student Completes Intent to Enroll Form
3. Student Receives Email from kapstart (see below)
4. Student Completes NSO Part I and registers for NSO Part II
5. Student Attends NSO Part II and registers
6. Student Attends NSO Part III

NSO will continue to support Dual Credit and International students, but will also include "new" transfer students (TYE population) starting this semester. This change is due to the implementation of STAR Registration and the need for new transfer students to have their transcripts evaluated prior to registration, as well as our new definition of first-year students (0-19 earned credits = FY student) in an attempt to improve retention and persistence. Cory will be sending out more information on this as we tweak this new process.

We would be very grateful for your continued support of NSO by attending as many as you are able.
