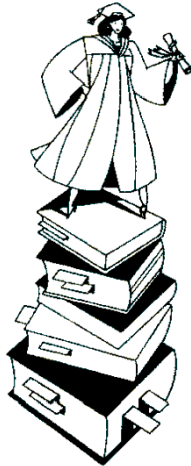

What is Phi Theta Kappa?



Phi Theta Kappa is an international honor society for two-year colleges. Alpha Kappa Iota is the name of the Phi Theta Kappa chapter at Honolulu Community College.

Why join Phi Theta Kappa?

You've earned it. A primary aim of Phi Theta Kappa is to recognize the outstanding academic achievements of students like you. Because we are an organization that encourages service to the college and community, you will have numerous opportunities to develop leadership, fellowship, scholarship, and service to your school and community. Members may participate in chapter, state, and national activities.



How much does it cost?

Lifetime membership costs a total of \$85. This includes a one-time \$60 international membership fee, a \$10 regional membership fee, and \$15 in chapter dues.

What are the requirements?

- You must complete at least 12 HCC credits in your major with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5; not including developmental Math, English & ESL courses.
- You must currently be enrolled with a minimum of 3 credits.
- You must have less than 15% of your attempted courses with Ns and Ws.

You may remain a member in good standing by maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0. All members are invited to take part in chapter activities.

Your participation is encouraged.

How do I join?

Your transcript will be evaluated by the HCC Honors Committee to determine your eligibility for membership. You will be notified of a decision in writing.
