Staff may submit items for posting. This is also a subscription service wherein an email digest is sent to subscribers on a daily basis. This feeds calendars on the MyUH Portal, KCC homepage and Intranet homepage.
LISTSERV Mailing Lists	LISTSERVs with web-interface for list managers. Used for mailing lists across campus including PPAC, Deans, Department Chairs/Unit Heads, and various departments.	primarily employees, some use for student groups	UH ITS	A mailing list or a discussion list is a tool that provides a way to disseminate information to a group of people. A single e-mail address is used in place of listing every recipient's email address separately. The University of Hawaii uses the LISTSERV mailing list software. LISTSERV allows for list moderation, user-requested subscriptions, multiple list owners, and many more features. Owners of LISTSERV lists can manage their lists via a web interface or by sending commands in the body of an email message.

Email can be targeted to distinct groups such as sending email to only students at a specific campus, faculty and staff at a specific campus, or a combination of groups.	students, employees (user must designate faculty or staff)	UH ITS	The Broadcast Service allows UH units to send notices and announcements that may be of interest to the UH community.
