- For active military members, the Military Orders and Military Verification Form.
- For veteran exemption students, the Veteran Exemption for Non-Resident Tuition Form, DD-214, and Certificate of Eligibility.
- To support your application to selective restricted access programs or majors.
- A \$25 application fee for most non-resident applicants.
